Driving Directions from I-5

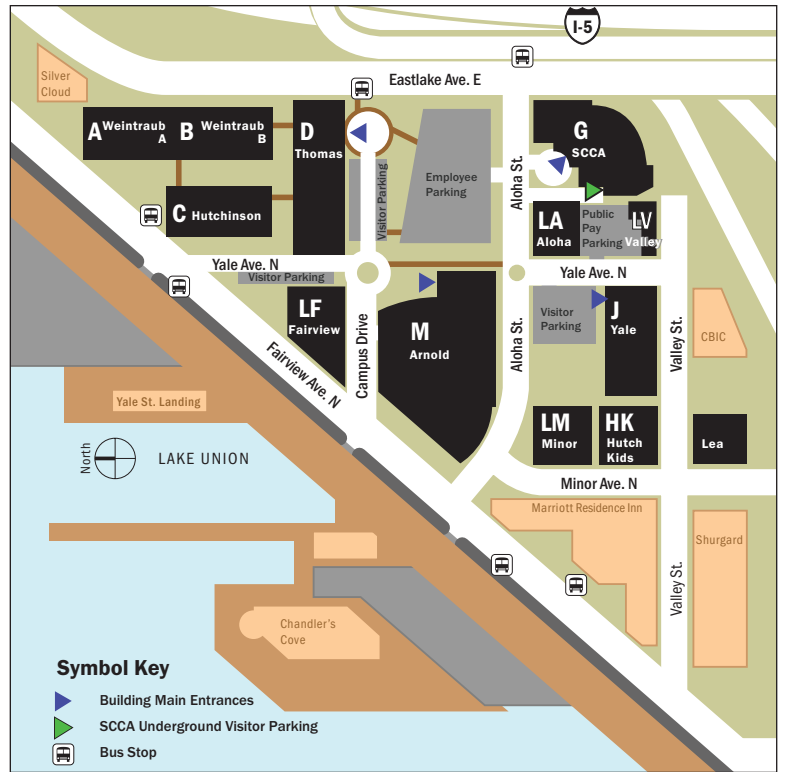
- **Exit Mercer** Exit #167
