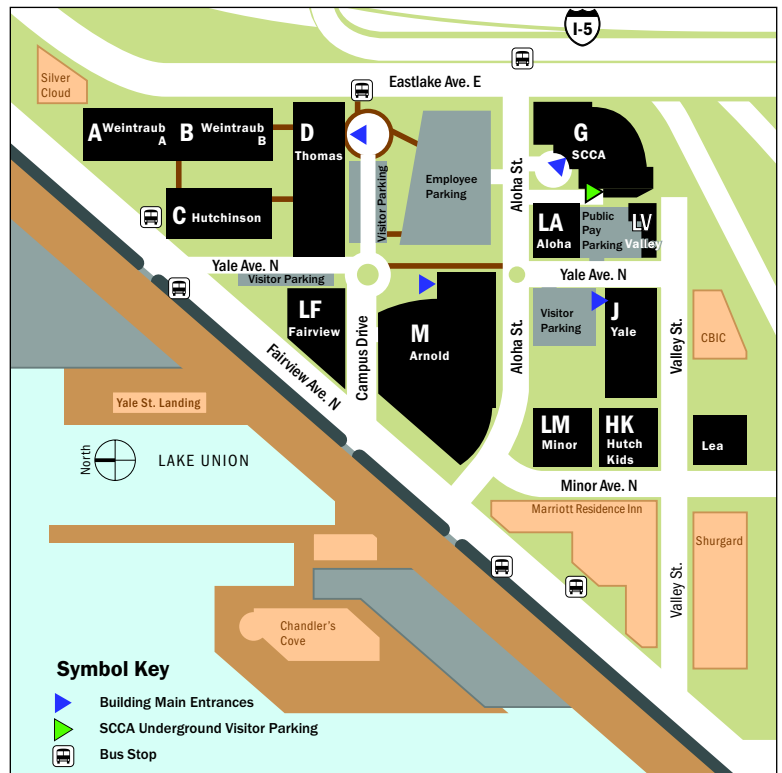
- **Exit Mercer** Exit #167
